He sacrificed his profession of law and propelled through the lofty hurdles, finally achieving his aim of establishing SBSPGI- a Biomedical Institute in 1994, by shaping the landscape at Balawala, into a sacred abode of learning in which School of Pharmaceuticals Sciences & Technology, School of Life Sciences, School

of Agriculture & Forestry, School of Allied Health Sciences, School of Applied Chemistry & Basic Sciences and School of Commerce & Management came up.

## PARTICIPANTS OF CONTEST

Participants must be bonafide students of the participating Institution, enrolled for the undergraduate or postgraduate courses of study in current academic session in any recognized College/Institute/University in the country. Full time research scholars are also eligible for participation in the debate. There will be two categories for evaluation of debate competition i.e

- 1) English
- 2) Hindi.

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1) Eligibility of the speakers for participation in Sardar Gurcharan Singh Memorial 11<sup>th</sup> National Debate Competition is that he/she has participated in debate competitions at District/State/National level. It is mandatory for the students to send the attested photocopy/copies of their certificates along with the registration forms.
- 2) The participating Institute has to send two students, one to present 'For' and the other to present 'Against' the topic. An Institute can send maximum two teams for the competition.
- 3) The total time for debate will be 5 + 1 minutes.
- 4) Speaker can present his/her point either in English or Hindi subjected to the category selected for the competition.
- 5) Evaluation of the competition will be done in both the languages separately.
- 6) Competitors with written debate will not be eligible for prizes. However, a slip of paper bearing points only will be permitted.
- 7) Admission to the debate will be subject to the presentation of a letter of the credentials from the Head of the Institution/ Cultural/ Literary Coordinator/ Dean Student Welfare certifying the bonafide status of the participants.
- 8) Verdict of the judges will be final. No protest or objection with regard to either the decision or procedure will be entertained.
- 9) Speaking order of the participants shall be decided on the basis of draw of lots.
- 10) Names of the participants should reach the Convener, Debating Society, Sardar Bhagwan Singh University, Balawala, Dehradun-248161, on the prescribed form duly forwarded by the Head of the Institution by 07<sup>th</sup> April 2019.

## REGISTRATION

Participants are requested to register for the National Debate Competition. There is no registration fee for the competition.
