

SBS University organized One Week Training Programme for B.Sc Agriculture Final Year Students



Sardar Bhagwan Singh University, Dehradun organized one week training program between (2-8) March for B.Sc. Agriculture final year students at Anupam Agro, Kuanwala under Agro Industrial Attachment Program. During this programme, Mr. M. H. Mishra (Director, Anupam Agro) interacted with the students and explained the procedure and types of methods involved in production of compost. He also briefed about the production, storage and management of mushroom seed (spawn). Students got information about the use of boiling wheat, mixing of chemicals and use of polypropylene bags instead of glass bottles in the process of mushroom production. Students came to know about the duration of long method (25-28) days and short method (15-20) days for compost preparation. Mr. Mishra explained about how short method of compost preparation was beneficial over long method as mushroom can grow around any season using short method because of right temperature, humidity, CO₂. Students also came to

know about the medicinal and health benefits of mushroom. The program was coordinated by Mr. Anil Panwar (Program Coordinator) and Dr. Deepika Chauhan.
